Dear :

You are receiving this letter because you previously registered and were deemed eligible to receive free medical monitoring testing as part of the Settlement Agreement reached in the above class action filed in the Circuit Court of Putnam County, West Virginia. **The second round of free medical testing will begin May 1, 2018 and end on August 31, 2018.**

The medical monitoring test protocol¹ will consist of the following:

A History and physical examination;
Fasting* Glucose;
Hemoglobin A1C;
Fasting* Lipid Profile;
Erythrocyte Sedimentation Rate; and
CBC with Differential.

Again, such medical monitoring testing is being made available to you free of charge and without any cost to you. In order to receive this free medical testing, you simply need to stop by Thomas Memorial Hospital's Nitro Care Clinic location. The address is 6A Bank Street, Nitro, West Virginia. The Clinic is open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. You do not need an appointment; however, you may call the Clinic at (304) 414-2982 if you have any questions. Please bring a photo ID with you so that the Clinic can properly identify you from the eligible participant roster that has been provided to the Clinic.

¹ If you were under 20 years of age during the initial medical monitoring testing in 2015, you will also be eligible for one-time serum dioxin testing.

* You must fast for 12 hours prior to the glucose and lipid profile blood tests.

Under the terms of the Settlement Agreement, if the initial results from any of the above blood tests are positive, you will be eligible for repeat testing within 30 days. A report summarizing the results of your testing and attaching supporting data will be subsequently sent to you or your primary care physician at your option.

By Order entered September 8, 2017, the Circuit Court of Putnam County adopted agreed modifications to the Medical Monitoring Class Settlement Agreement based upon negotiations between Class Counsel and counsel for Monsanto. Under the terms of that modification and Court Order, the above medical monitoring testing will occur every two years until the year 2042 rather than every five years as originally agreed between the parties. A copy of that Order is available on the website at www.bibbclass.com. You will remain eligible for testing regardless of whether you choose to participate during any given testing period.
